

**POWER RANCH VOTED BEST MASTER PLANNED COMMUNITY
IN MARICOPA COUNTY BY “RANKING ARIZONA”**

Power Ranch in Gilbert has been named the best master planned community in Maricopa County by “Ranking Arizona: The Best of Arizona Business.”

Each of Power Ranch’s two clubhouses is surrounded by a seven-acre park and a catch-and-release fishing lake with lakeside trails. There is also a 10-acre soccer complex.

A full-time, on-site lifestyle director manages a variety of programs, classes, clubs and annual events for kids and adults.
